Lab Reports give vital clues as to the motive and method of murder and possibly give clues to the murderer.

THE EVIDENCE

Evidence has been found and details of this appears on the back of some ID badges.

Seek out as much of this evidence as possible to discover vital clues to the identity or the murderer and the motive.

FIND THE MURDERER

To solve this murder mystery you must find clues. Clues are all found on the ID badges of everyone at camp.

You should try to look at as many clues as possible. If someone asks to see your clue then you do not have to show them and they do not have to show you theirs! But you may wish to work together to solve the mystery!

Making notes about each suspect as you find the clues.

Sherlock Holmes once said "if you eliminate all the suspects but one then he or she is the killer no matter how unlikely."

So to find the killer you need to eliminate each of the suspects using the available clues. Ask each of the suspects if you wish, but they may lie to you even if they are innocent.
